Our Mission

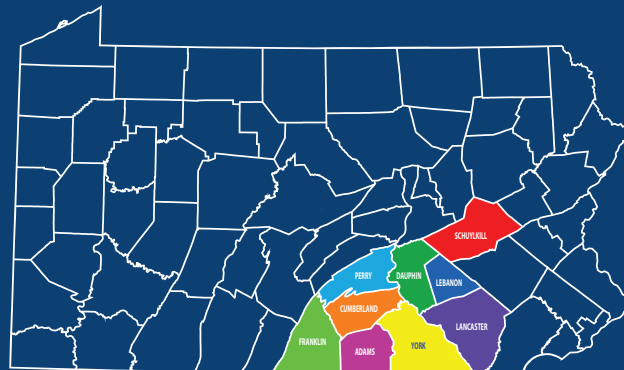
